# Message from The Principal



On Monday the Jumeirah College community was shaken by the tragedy of the death of Shibin Thomas. Shibin had worked at the school as part of our administration and support team for seven years. He was a quiet man, but one who was always smiling and encouraging others. Shibin was a husband and father and one of his many passions was his love for cricket. Shibin worked tirelessly in support of the school and our students. He was also a very close friend to many of the staff at the school.

Over the last three days we have focussed on supporting all members of the community as we all grieve and come to terms with what has happened. Counsellors have been at the school to speak to students and staff, and this has included counsellors who are fluent in both Urdu and Hindi to ensure everyone has had the opportunity to speak in their home language. Assemblies have also been held with every year group to reflect on events and to discuss how we can begin to carry on. I have always known that the core strength of the school is our community and how we look after each other, irrespective of year group, background or role. This sense of togetherness is unquestionably being tested at the moment, but I know that we will carry on and move forward together.

This newsletter marks the start of our memorial to Shibin. We are placing a Book of Remembrance in reception to enable messages to be passed on to Shibin's family. I have been very grateful for the many ideas students and parents have suggested on how we can remember Shibin and support his friends here. This will be our focus moving forward.

I would like to thank everyone who has reached out to offer condolences and support over the last few days. I have been genuinely overwhelmed by the messages that we have received from not only parents and friends but also from both the national and international education community. Shibin's family and friends are continually in our thoughts and prayers at this difficult time.
