



A level Results 2016



- Our Sixth Form students achieved record results at both AS and A2.
- At A2 14% of results were at A*, with 46% at either A* or A and 76% A*-B
- Of the 129 students in Year 13, 73 of them gained nothing below a B grade
- At AS, 51% of all grades were A, and 76% were either A or B. 42 students gained straight A grades
- The Business Studies department attained results at AS that rank it as one of the top departments in the world
- Highest achievers were at A2 Daniel Nashad with 4 A*s, Sasha Nanda with 3 A*s and 2 As. Axella Talma achieved 3 A*s, 1 A and 1 B; and Taimur Murad gained 3 A*s and 1 A

University destinations 2016



These outstanding results have enabled our students to move on to destinations around the world.

Again this year, a number of our students have secured places at top American universities. Vedant Bahl will major in Economics at Harvard University, Sasha Nanda in Physics at CalTech, Daniel Nashed in Civil Engineering at UCLA, and Axelle Talma will study at Stanford University. A number of the cohort have also gone on to study in Canada, including Ahmad Masri, who will study Mechanical Engineering at McGill University.

Six students have accepted places at LSE - Tasha Chia goes on to study Politics and International Relations, while Taimur Murad will study Maths. A further six students have also secured places at University College London in courses ranging from Medicine to Engineering. Kate Naylor goes on to study International Relations at Kings College London while Aditya Gorla has accepted a place to study Biomedical Engineering at Imperial College London.

All 6 of our medical applicants were successful, including one in dentistry, as we maintained our 100% success rate of the last four years of students securing places on medical courses.

Year 11 students also achieved records breaking results.

- Every student gained 5 or more A*-C, with 99% achieving this measure including English and Maths
- 64% of all results were either A* or A grade. 88% were A*-B
- 67% of the students achieved 5 or more A*/As, and 48% achieved 8 or more A*/A
- 30 students achieved straight A*/A grades and 84 students achieved all A*-B grades
- ICT achieved a clean sweep of A*/A grades with 25 of each
- Particular congratulations go to Jasmina Eldamanhoury, Ines Roze, Kelly Stewart, Khadijah Anwar, Rahul Lobo and Sadaf Sahal; all of whom achieved 10 or more A*s
