



# Jumeirah College 2017 Results

## A Level

This year was the largest student cohort to be entered for A levels at Jumeirah College and the school, yet again, broke all previous records.

Of over 400 examination entries, for 138 students:

- 19% achieved the prestigious A\* grade
- 54% of all results were at either A\* or A grade, as compared to the UK national average of 26%
- 7 students achieved straight A\*s
- 39 students (28%) achieved all A\*/ A grades
- 93 students (67%) achieved grades no lower than a B

# Jumeirah College 2017 Results

## GCSE

This academic year has seen the introduction of new specifications in English Literature, English Language and Mathematics – which includes the introduction of the new 1-9 grades. These exams are significantly more challenging, both in terms of the expected knowledge required and the skills students are expected to exhibit. In addition, the linear nature of the courses and the reduction in coursework means that there is a far greater loading on the end of the course.

- 63% of student entries obtained were A\*/A grades or equivalent
- 29 students (18%) gained straight A\*/A grades or equivalent, in all subjects
- 98% of our students gained 5 A\*/C grades or equivalent
- 85 students (52%) achieved all A\*- B grades or equivalent
- 90 grades at A\*- B or equivalent
- Overall, students achieved 49 of the new 9 grades
