Dear Student,

Our main priority at JC is to make sure you are able to learn in a safe and friendly environment where you feel protected and nurtured so you can fulfil your potential. Our aim is to make you feel empowered whilst understanding your rights and responsibilities.

What is safeguarding and why is it important?

Safeguarding is about promoting the welfare of all children so you feel safe, secure and respected. Safeguarding includes protecting children from any form of abuse in school or at home. This includes emotional abuse, sexual abuse, physical abuse and neglect.

Safeguarding is everything we do in school to promote your safety and Child Protection is responding to a particular child's safety needs.

All children have the right to protection, regardless of age, gender, ethnicity, disability or beliefs.

This responsibility is underpinned by the following aims:

- To protect children from harm (maltreatment).
- To prevent impairment of children's health and development.
- To ensure children grow up in circumstances consistent with the provision of safe and effective care.
- To take action to enable all children to have the best outcomes.

Principles upon which the Safeguarding Policy is based:


- The welfare of a child will always be paramount.
- The welfare of families will be continuously promoted.
- The rights, wishes and feelings of children and their families will be respected and listened to.
- Keeping children safe from harm requires people who work with children to share information.
- All staff within Jumeirah College will work in accordance with the interests of all children.
