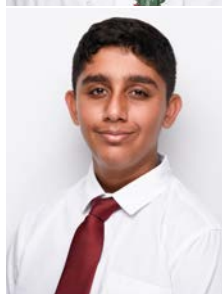
Younis Naeem 8M2

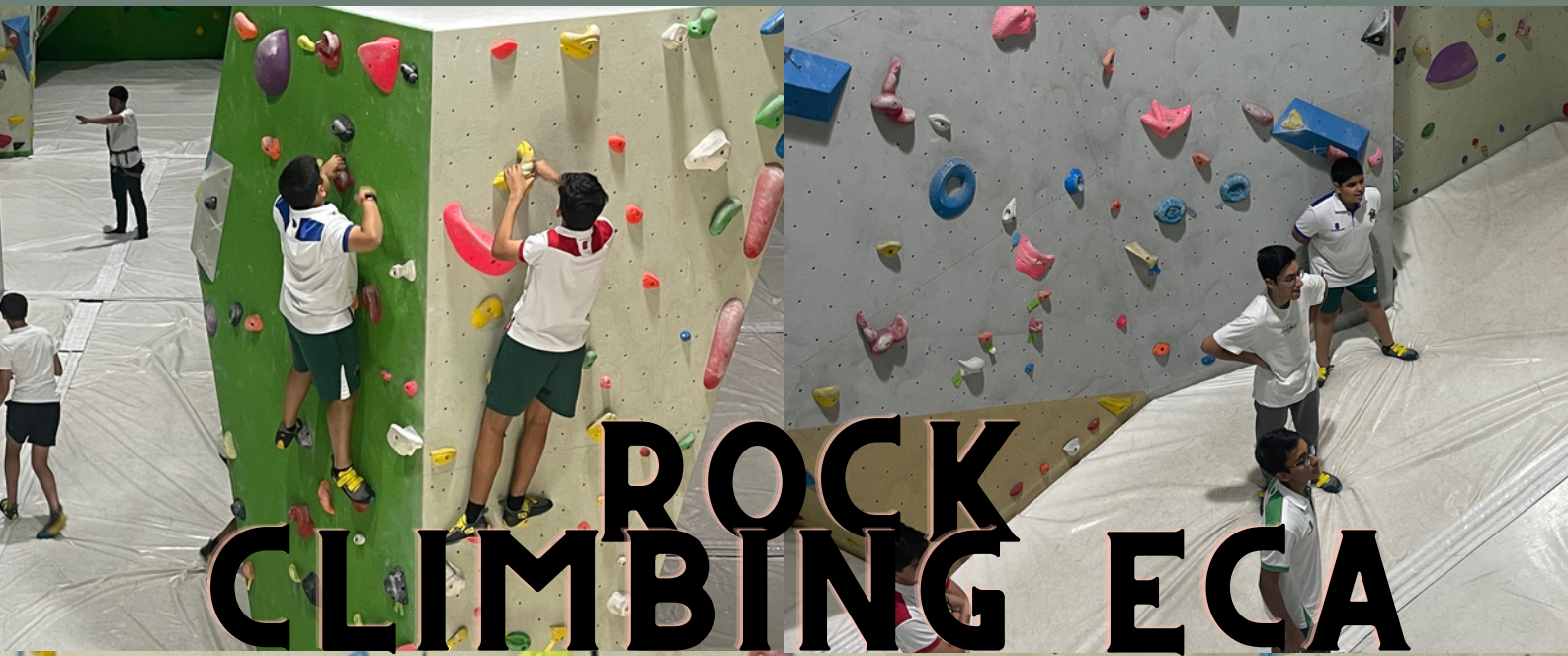
